Launched during the 2017-18 academic year, the Valley Jazz Cooperative Scholarship program is designed to recognize outstanding young people, in support of their post-secondary education. Scholarships are awarded annually to three current or former Valley Jazz Cooperative ensemble participants, as they approach the conclusion of their senior year in high school. Scholarship recipients are talented, young creatives. However, in the awarding of these scholarships, particular consideration is given to those individuals who make meaningful contributions to their communities through *service to others*. As a long-term goal, the VJC encourages these scholarship recipients to continue to make a positive impact on society through community engagement and service, as well as support for/participation in the arts.
